Fall Semester

- **7TH GRADE – FOUNDATIONS OF FAITH**
Foundations of Faith is designed specifically for 7th graders to focus on the absolute core elements of being a disciple of Jesus. For people checking out the faith it's a great introduction. For already-believers it's an important refresher.
- **8TH – 12TH – CURRICULUM BASED ON SUNDAY MORNING TEACHING**
We believe that it's always beneficial to dig deeper into truths communicated on Sunday mornings. We take advantage of this each Fall semester, always aligning our curriculum with what is being taught on Sunday mornings. This does not mean that everyone who attends cell group must attend Fellowship. We try to craft it in a way that will be beneficial for everyone attending.

Spring Semester

- **7TH GRADE – FOUNDATIONS OF CHARACTER**
Following up on the Fall's Foundations of Faith curriculum, we discuss how to live out our faith.
- **8TH GRADE – RELATIONSHIPS**
God is not only the creator of all relationships, but He Himself exists in an eternal relationship within the trinity. These 10 lessons walk through some of the most important relationships people can have with Biblical insights and practical advice designed for students.
- **9TH GRADE – LIFE OF CHRIST**
This curriculum highlights major events in Jesus' life. From His birth to His death on the cross, you will find these 12 lessons are extremely valuable to walk through with your cell group students.
- **10TH GRADE – STUDYING YOUR BIBLE**
This curriculum is designed to help cell group leaders teach a 12 week curriculum series on studying the Bible.
