BE ON TIME

When students arrive (especially in NES), it is important that they have someone to connect to. You communicate value to students when you are present and on time!

RALLY THE KIDS YOU KNOW

Discover the routine for your group and roll with it. Kids like to have a familiar place to connect and a familiar face to talk to when they arrive.

INCLUDE VISITORS

We'll try to bring visitors to you but try to keep an eye out for loners, wanderers, and stragglers. Welcome new students into your circle. Talk to them about cell group or just ask questions about where a person lives, goes to school, etc. Invite them to sit with you and your group.

BE A LEADER

Model taking notes and bringing your Bible (hard copy). Don't be the one distracting your students. We rely on our leaders to regulate cell phone usage, discourage side conversations, and prevent disruptive coming and going.
