FAITH IN THE GOD OF PROMISE

Read Joshua 2 aloud as a group.

- With the person next to you, describe the story that takes place in Joshua 2. Tell all that you remember with as much detail as possible, names, places, objects, etc.
- Is there a character you relate most with? Joshua, the spies, Rahab, the king?
- What else have you learned about Joshua so far?

THEN

Joshua 2:1-7

- Is Rahab a righteous woman? Defend your answer.
- Up to this point in the story, what defines Rahab?

Joshua 2:8-13

- What is the theme or 'meat' of this section?
- Why does Rahab plead for kindness?
- Now, what defines Rahab? Is she a righteous woman? Defend your answer.

Joshua 2:14-21

- How do the spies respond to Rahab's plea?
- Why do you think the story includes the detail of a 'scarlet cord'? What is the connection between the Passover, Rahab, and the cross?
- Why was Rahab saved?

NOW

- Why are you saved? By whom? Are you righteous? Where does that righteousness come from?
- Do you relate with Rahab? Why?

- **Take some time now to write out your own spiritual story. Make sure to include where you have come from, where you think you are going, why you think this, etc. What character in Joshua 2 is most like you in the story you write out?**
